Directions:

Located in the Scenic Santa Ynez Valley between Santa Barbara and Solvang.

- Take the 101 North to Santa Barbara
- Exit State Street/ Lake Cachuma, highway 154
- Transition on to Highway 154 and follow it for about 17 miles over and through the San Marcos Pass. Rancho Alegre is on the left side of the road.
- On the right side of the road, just before the camp entrance on the left there is an emergency highway phone by the number 154-16.3. The portion of the road at that point is straight and then goes into a sweeping down left and curves up to Lake Cachuma entrance which is 1/2 mile past the Ranch entrance.
